**Client codes/acronyms:**

IFF = infant formula feeding

IPN = infant partially nursing (breastfeeding) - breastfeeding at least once a day

IPN+ = infant partially nursing, but receiving more than the maximal amount of formula for the IPN code

IEN = infant exclusively nursing (breastfeeding) - no infant formula

PG1 = pregnant woman < 17 years old (i.e. 17 years old and below)

PG2 = pregnant woman > 18 years old (i.e. 18 years old and above)

PP = post partum women up to 6 months after infant's birth (formula feeding the infant) – Listed as “P” in the chart above

EN = post partum woman exclusively nursing up to one year after the infant's birth

PN = post partum woman partially nursing up to 6 months after the infant's birth

PN+ = mother of infant who is IPN+ who will be counted as breastfeeding, but will receive the PP food benefit rather than the PN food benefit (i.e. less food benefit)

C1 = children from 12 up to 24 months of age

C2 = children from 24 up to 36 months of age

C3 = children from 36 up to 48 months of age

C4 = children from 48 up to 60 months of age
